# Benefits Of Rain Barrels

## How it helps YOU:

- Saves money by lowering water bills and sewage bills
- Provides relief for poor drainage areas
- Water is naturally softened, free of chlorine, lime, and calcium
- Great source of backup water during water restriction periods

## Saving Water and Money

Studies show that residential water consumption increases around 40-50% in the summer months. The cost of water consumption has increased sharply, not only for usage, but for discharge as well. Many towns have also been forced to impose water restrictions as well in recent years. Rain barrels can help you and your community.

## Rain Barrels Sold

The Morris County Soil Conservation District sells pre-assembled, environmentally safe, food grade barrels for a very low price. We offer normal rain barrels (blue or white) and pre-painted rain barrels. The cost? **\$125 to \$300+** for most commercial advertised barrels,

## Does it work?

Only 1/4 of an inch of rain off an average roof can fill a rain barrel. During peak summer months, **you can save about 1,200 gallons a WEEK!** One inch of rainfall on a 1,000 square foot roof will yield about 600 gallons of water.
